



Christian Beliefs -- "Statement of Faith"

Revision is committed to the Old and New Testament as the only authoritative rule of faith and practice. Therefore, our faith and conduct is formed by the standards of these Scriptures.

1. the Bible is the only inspired, infallible and authoritative Word of God (2 Timothy 3:16, 1 Peter 1:25)
2. there is only one God, revealed as Father, Son, and Holy spirit (Matthew 28:19, John 1:14, Acts 5:3, 2 Corinthians 13:14)
3. the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, His virgin birth, His sinless life, His miracles, His atoning death through His shed blood, His bodily resurrection, and His ascension to the right hand of the Father and His personal return in power and glory (Matthew 1:23, John 1:14, Matthew 24:36, 1 Thessalonians 4:16)
4. while we were sinners, Jesus died for the atonement of our sins (John 3:16)
5. a person becomes justified by grace through faith in the Lord Jesus Christ (1 John 1:14, Romans 10:6)
6. the present ministry of the Holy Spirit by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life (Acts 1:5, 19:1, Galatians 5:16, Ephesians 4:30)
7. the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; they that are saved unto the resurrection of life and they that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation (John 14:2, Revelation 7:15, Matthew 13:41, Revelation 20:10)
8. the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ and His church (Acts 16:5, Hebrews 10:24)
